We begin by exploring your inner personality. There are four core numbers that outline your basic personality and form the foundational building blocks of who you are. These core numbers are based on calculations using your birth date and birth name.

Kate, your core analysis is made up of the following numbers:

Life Path - Eight; Expression - Seven; Soul Urge - Six; Birthday - Six

Your core analysis is interesting in that it only has the numbers six, seven and eight. The number six is repeated twice in your chart, however it is balanced by the numbers seven and eight in what is quite an unusual combination. Number six indicates a love of home and others, seven is a philosophical number that needs time alone to mull over the mysteries of the

universe, while number eight is eminently powerful in a practical, ambitious and goal orientated way.

1) INNER PERSONALITY

1.1 Life Path

This is the most important number in your profile and makes up 40% of your chart. The Life Path describes the nature of your journey through life. It represents who you are at birth, the traits you carry with you through life, and reveals your purpose in life.

1.2 Expression

The Upside

3) FUTURE TRENDS

3.1 Pinnacle Cycles

3.2 Personal Year

Your personal year number in numerology gives you a snapshot of the upcoming calendar year. Each personal year is part of a nine-year cycle, beginning when you reached numerological maturity at age 28 and repeating again after every ninth year.

This is a number two personal year and is a slower gentler year. In many ways it is a consolidation year. You have a well balanced birth chart with numbers in the mental, emotional and practical, as well as thought, will and action planes. More numbers in the emotional and will planes indicate that your strength lies in your intuition and deep understanding and sensitivity for feelings and emotions. You also have the determination to persist in putting your ideas into action in a practical way.

4.1 Arrows of Strength and Vulnerability

There are fifteen possible arrows or lines that can appear in a chart, although many charts do not have any. Arrows of strength occur when three numbers appear together in a row, horizontally, vertically or diagonally. They indicate natural talent and areas where you can quickly move ahead. Arrows of vulnerability occur when there are three empty boxes in a row, again, either horizontally, vertically or diagonally. These indicate areas where you will need to make the greatest effort. We are all able to change our lives and these arrows give an indication of where we should start.

Your Area of Strength is Determination —————>

This arrow is made up of the diagonal numbers one, five and nine. People with it are determined, persistent, enterprising, intense and progressive. You have tremendous ability to face setbacks and adversities of life and stay dedicated to tasks until the goals are achieved. You are patient in that you are prepared to wait for what it is you have set your mind on. It is

not always easy to be patient for long periods of time and you might need to learn to control your temper. This is particularly the case if the number four is missing from your chart. Your Area of Strength is Willpower —————>

This arrow is made up of the numbers four, five and six. it is an uncommon arrow but one that gives considerable strength and endurance. One 9 - Kate, as a true humanitarian with a strong desire to serve your fellow man, you are caring, understanding, and support and assist others. You are also ambitious and have a strong desire to improve yourself. Mother Theresa is an example of someone with one nine in her birth chart.

Missing Numbers

Numbers that are missing from the chart often indicate the missing traits or characteristics, desirable or undesirable, from a persons profile. They also highlight some important lessons one needs to learn, or maybe some important habits to cultivate, in order to lead a more balanced life.

Missing Three

People without number three in their charts may suffer from a lack of self-confidence, and may also find it hard to express themselves. This carries on for the initial years of their lives, and

improves only once they learn to accept themselves as they are. Once that happens, they gain confidence, self belief and self-esteem from all their endeavours. Until then, you tend to underestimate your abilities, which leads to a self-effacing attitude. Also, you lack the ability to think logically when faced with distractions and roadblocks.

Missing Seven
